Honing his skills began more than 25 years ago while working in larger shops. Scott took what he learned and left behind the aspects of the business he did not like to open his own repair shop in his hometown.

"We are very much technicians today and not mechanics," said Scott Hansen of Scott's Automotive in Concord, Nebraska.

"We do a lot of suspension, alignment, and

We get paid by the job, by the hour. In other words, whatever it takes to do the job right, that is what we do here," he said.
